It intends to utilize part of the agreed amount for this loan for payments to the Consultancy for Preparation of the Project Completion Report (PCR)

The Tanzania Petroleum Development Corporation (TPDC) as beneficiary and implementing agency now invite eligible individual consultants to indicate interest in providing the services of preparing the Project Completion Reports (PCs) The consultant will undertake: review of the overall status of implementation of the project, and the progress made towards the achievement of the project's development objectives which include but not limited to the following tasks:

  - ii. Review and documentation of the physical implementation achievements in terms of planned output targets by components;
  - iii. Documenting the achievements in the procurement of goods and services, including the implementation of the project procurement plan;
  - iv. Assessment of the project performance in respect of financial management, including the management of disbursement tasks, and efficiency of resource use;
