CONSTRUCTION OF HONEY PROCESSING HOUSE IN LONGIDO DISTRICT

Introduction

Stretching from Lake Victoria to the Indian Ocean, the Southern Kenya - Northern Tanzania (SOKNOT) transboundary area covers some 134,000 km2. The area is famous for its conservation areas, including the Serengeti, Maasai-Mara, Tsavo, Kilimanjaro and the Ngorongoro crater, important biospheres and bird habitats including Lake Natron, Loita, Amboseli and West Kilimanjaro. There are 39 communal conservancies and 3 Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs) that reflect their extraordinary biodiversity and tourism value. The landscape is home to millions of wild animals including threatened and endangered species such as elephant, black rhino, lion, cheetah. hirola and African wild dog.

WWF Tanzania Country Office (WWF TCO) is implementing a SOKNOT transboundary program, The Land for Life (L4L) project funded by WWF-UK and the UK's Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO) focusing on securing livelihood and empowering vulnerable Maasai communities whilst recovering wildlife In critical corridors, addressing the need for Human - Wildlife Conflict (HWC) mitigation and supporting sustainable rangeland management in the project areas.

Specifically, this tender aims at building an apiculture value addition products center that will improve the economic well-being of beekeepers in Longido District.

In that regard, WWF TCO through the SOKNOT programme invites eligible Tanzanian Contractors registered in Building Works Class VII and above by relevant Authorities/Bodies to bid for the tender.
