Oikos East Africa under BMZ Unganisha project funded by The German Cooperation in partnership with WWF Tanzania is implementing a transboundary project that seeks to restore key natural resources across the Kilimanjaro and Mkomazi landscapes to bring benefits to wildlife and people. The project focuses on securing critical wildlife corridors and dispersal areas, therefore working on addressing various drivers in critical forests, farmlands, rangeland ecosystems, and wildlife corridors for the benefit of biodiversity and people.

One of the project objectives is to develop a model of connectivity beyond road barriers for the West Kilimanjaro area, including a pilot road ecology analysis, develop a mitigation plan and implement measures to reduce traffic-related wildlife mortality on the Arusha-Namanga T2 road. As part of our efforts to monitor and mitigate roadkill incidents along the T2 road, we intend to install advanced CCTV cameras and related equipment including control room equipment, capable of monitoring wildlife and vehicle collisions leading to legal actions by the police forces.

Oikos invites tenderers to supply and install high-quality CCTV cameras with the capability to capture clear footage both during the day and at night for continuous monitoring along designated road sections (8 hotspots within a distance of 32 km).

The interested suppliers must meet and show in their proposal the following requirements:

- a. Proven track record in supplying and installing CCTV cameras on roads, especially to monitor vehicles and wildlife or road incidences.
